Our parade will include:

- Diploma pick-up
- Yearbook distribution
- Reading of your name as you drive thru
- Graduation Program

Guidelines:

- Graduates must wear their cap & gown in order to enter the parade
- Graduates and vehicle passengers must wear a mask at all times
- Limit of ONE vehicle per graduate. No limos, RV's, party busses will be admitted
- Graduates may not ride in a convertible or rear of a pick-up truck.
- No one is allowed to exit the vehicle under any circumstances
- For health reasons, please do not purchase merchandise from street vendors near campus
- No spectators allowed due to city and county guidelines

What should Graduates wear?

- Custom maroon cap and gown
- Regalia (cords, stoles, patches) issued by school clubs & organizations
- Gentlemen (suggested attire): dress shirt, tie, dark pants and dress shoes or your Sunday best
- Ladies (suggested attire): dress or blouse w/pants/skirt, and dress shoes or your Sunday best

Common Q & A

- Can I decorate my cap? **YES**, but it must be tasteful and follow school dress code policy.
- Can I get out to take pics? NO, all graduates and their guest must remain in the car.
- Can we go in two cars if I have a big family? **NO**, one car per graduate.
- Can we go through the parade on both days? NO, diplomas will only be available based on last name scheduled date.
- Can I participate if I did not meet graduation requirements? **Yes**, this is not a graduation ceremony but a celebration.
- How much are the yearbooks? Yearbooks are complimentary for such an extraordinary class!
- Do I have to be there exactly at 1:00 pm? **No**. The entrance to the parade is open from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm? Please expect traffic delays.
- Is this the graduation ceremony? **NO**, this is a celebration of your accomplishments. Your Graduation Ceremony will be virtual on June 16, 2020 at 6:00 pm.
- Can I decorate my car? **YES**, but it must be tasteful and appropriate for a school setting. Any cars that do not comply will be denied entry.
- Will all students receive a diploma? **NO**, only students that have met the graduation requirements will receive their diploma however all students will receive a diploma holder cover.

Traffic Routes

- Cars will enter the parade through the parking structure entrance on Duncan Street.
- Cars will exit the parade by the Marco Antonio Firebaugh statue onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.
- Expect heavy traffic and delays. Cars should line up along Duncan heading towards Walnut Ave and Louise Street.
